


SHARING NETWORKED MUSIC TO AN OVATION MUSIC STREAMER On a Mac OSX 10.8.2

STEP 1: LOCATE CLIENT'S MUSIC


If you already know where the music files are, you can skip this step, but if you do not, here are some things you can do to find them.

MUSIC IN iTunes

1. Open iTunes and select Preferences from the iTunes menu.



2. Click on the Advanced button on the top of the Preferences window.





3. The "iTunes Media folder location" indicates the locations of your iTunes music.

! **Note:** DRM protected iTunes files (ending in the "m4p" extension) cannot be played.

STEP 2: SHARING A FOLDER


1. Open the System Preferences - Open the Apple menu in the upper left corner of the desktop and choose System Preferences from the dropdown menu.
2. Open the Sharing Preferences - Find the Sharing icon in the System Preferences window under Internet & Wireless and click it. This opens the Sharing Preferences.



3. Click File Sharing on the left in the list of services.
4. If File Sharing is Off



A) Click the Options button on the right. This will open a dropdown window.

B) In the dropdown window, choose "Share files and folders using SMB (Windows)" to enable sharing for other network computers. Make sure a reasonable account is selected to run the service on. Enter a password if prompted.



5. Add the folder to share - Under the list of Shared Folders, click the “+” to add a folder to share. In the folder selection window, navigate to the folder you want to share and click [Add].



6. Set user permissions - In the Shared Folders list, make sure the folder is selected. Verify there is an Everyone user in the Users list (add “Everyone” if necessary). Then change Everyone’s permissions to “Read & Write”.



7. Close the Sharing Preferences.

8. Your folder is now shared and available on the network.
